NUMBER ONES (Worn for special or formal occasions in and out of school):

- 1 Royal Blue Blazer with school crest

INSTRUCTIONS AND NOTES

1. EVERY article must be CLEARLY marked with the boy's name (on inside of collars and waistbands of trousers and shorts). Nametapes should have not only the boy's initials, but should include, after his name, the capital letter indicating his House. NOTE – No Iron-On labels.

For example: JONES G (E)

Each year the school undertakes to place a mass order of 200 nametapes for each D Block (Form One) boy ONLY, and parents will receive these from us at the end of the year. Their cost will be charged to your account.

2. No responsibility can be accepted for any article not clearly marked.
3. All articles must be sent in a proper state of repair.
4. In the event of a boy not having all the required uniform or equipment, the Housemaster must be regarded as having the parent's authority to arrange for the purchase for him, through the school, of the necessary articles.
5. Clothing must be of such material as can be washed by machine. Materials requiring hand washing are unsuitable.
6. Please send your son to school with some articles of clothing which can be worn during his free time on Sundays: two sets of shorts, t-shirts, a bush hat, a jersey and a pair of casual shoes are sufficient in summer, with perhaps a pair of jeans and a tracksuit for the winter. Again, all such articles of clothing must be clearly marked.

STATIONERY LIST

Some basic stationery and toiletries are available from the School Shop.
Boys are required to bring the following standard stationery:
